REGISTRATION PACKAGE CANADIAN PARTICIPANTS

After a very successful SCOPE 2023 camp where we traveled to Pennsylvania in May 2023, part 2 of the exchange program, **SCOPE 2024, will take place in May 2024.** This time American Scouts will be travelling to join us at “Camp Woodland Trails” located just outside Stouffville, Ontario.

As with SCOPE 2019, there will be no “home hosting” and participants will arrive at camp Thursday evening and depart Sunday afternoon. There will be a fantastic out-trip on the Friday, and two full days of great program at camp. The camp will run from Thursday evening May 23rd to Sunday afternoon May 26th, 2024.

Why Attend SCOPE 2024?

This is a fantastic opportunity for international friendship and adventure. You’ll get to meet our American guests and learn about how Scouting works in their country. You’ll teach them things about Canadian Scouting and they’ll teach you things about American Scouting.

You’ll have fun – make new friends – and enjoy great programme activities and adventures.

This is one of those camps that past attendees have insisted we **MUST DO IT AGAIN** – every time!

This exchange program has been running since 1967, approximately every four years. Come and be part of it!

Eligibility

This camp is for Scouts, Venturer Scouts, and Rover Scouts of all ages; in addition, Howler Cub Scouts (those turning 11 in 2024) are also invited to attend.

All participants must be registered members of Scouts Canada (or a B-P Guild for offers of service), and those in a volunteer role must meet the following screening requirements, which must not expire before May 30th 2024:

- youth participant: Active in MyScouts with a Cub Scouts, Scouts, Venturer Scouts or Rover Scouts section
- youth offers of service: Active in MyScouts with Venturer Scouts or Rover Scouts, Respect in Sport, Scouting Fundamentals, recommendation letter from your Group Commissioner, and Youth Code of Conduct signed
- adult Scouters and adult offers of service: Fully screened and Active in MyScouts (RIS, SF, PRC/VSS, Adult Code of Conduct, reference checks, commissioner approval, Council approval)

Cost

The anticipated cost for this great event is \$ 275.00 per participant (youth or adult) but may be less based on number of participants who sign up. If there are enough participants to reduce the cost, the amount required for the balance due will be reduced accordingly. The fee includes all meals and all programme activities, including a great Friday out-trip!

Deposit due no later than January 15 th 2024	\$100
Balance due no later than March 28 th 2024	\$175 (or less – see above)

How to Register

STEP 1 – fill in the Letter of Intent (page 3 of this package) and send it in as directed no later than January 15th 2024, with your estimated numbers of participants

STEP 2 – sign up your participants within your section or group, and fill in the Section Registration Form (page 4 of this package) and have your participants fill in the Individual Registration Form (page 5 of this package) and send all forms as directed no later than January 31st 2024; include your Group or Section cheque for the deposit amount payable to “Scouts Canada”

STEP 3 – collect the balance payments from your participants and send a Group or Section cheque payable to “Scouts Canada” no later than March 28th 2024 along with the Section Balance Form (which will be sent to you once the cost has been finalized, in early February 2024)

STEP 4 – have each participant fill in a SCOPE Medical Form (which will be sent to you once your registration is finalized) and return it before camp following the instructions provided

STEP 5 – generate an AAF (Adventure Application Form) for all your participants, have your Group Commissioner approve it, and send it to us, together with your participant roster.

STEP 6 – come to SCOPE 2024 on May 23rd and have a fantastic adventure!

What to Bring

Participants will need to bring their own camping equipment (tents, stoves, kitchen utensils, etc.) and their own personal gear.

A list will be sent out closer to the camp with specific items to bring.
